Outplacement Student Enrollment Data

Report 1: Outplaced Enrollment

• For outplacement schools to verify the data RIDE receives from LEAs.

Report 2: Outplaced Student Report

• For LEAs that tuition students to outplacement schools.

Purpose:

- Student information for students in outplacement schools is often out-of-date and inaccurate.
- This application for outplacement schools and the outplaced enrollment report for LEAs will allow LEAs and the schools to see where there are inaccuracies in the enrollment data.



Outplaced Enrollment: Application for Outplacement Schools

For Outplacement Schools only. Outplacement school administrators must have RIDE Portal account.

• Create a RIDE Portal account at <u>https://portal.ride.ri.gov/Core/Default/CreateUser</u>

Steps for accessing the Outplaced Enrollment application:

- 1. Log in to RIDE portal: <u>https://portal.ride.ri.gov/Account/Login</u>
- 2. Click on All Applications on the left-hand side of the screen.
- **3.** Click on the Outplaced Enrollment application:



- 4. Click on STUDENTS in the header. Then SCHOOL YEAR will show.
- 5. Select the School Year: 2022-23




ACCESS for ELLs

Medical Exemptions – 2023 Process Review

RISAP Test Coordinator Handbook (page 18; Appendix E)

Submitting an exemption to RIDE:

School: Discuss the student's situation and need to request a medical exemption with the District Testing Coordinator and/or Superintendent. The Testing Coordinator and/or Superintendent may decline the school's request to submit a medical exemption.

School: Complete Forms 2 and 3 and provide to the district.

NEW for 2023 **District:** Once the school has Forms 2 and 3 complete, then the district can complete Form 1 (District Assurances Form) through the Medical Exemption application in eRIDE. There is no paper copy for 2023. Only the superintendent's office may submit a medical exemption.

RIDE: reviews Form 1 in the eRIDE system. If needed, RIDE will contact the principal or the superintendent for clarification if there are any questions.

RIDE: emails the superintendent when a decision has been reached.

NEW for 2023 **District:** Logs into eRIDE Medical Exemption application to review the decision.

Best Practices for Selecting Your Testing Windows

- 1. Determine how many staff you will need before selecting your testing window.
- 2. Use as much of the state testing window as possible. Even if your school testing window is over, if you're within the state assessment window, you can continue testing.

- 3. Plan to test 100% of students in each content area.
- 4. Start as early in the state primary testing window as possible.
- 5. Adhere to the state testing window for make-up testing.
