SUBJECT: NECAP Science Assessment

Happy spring! This correspondence is to remind you of this May's NECAP Science Assessment and the schedule of workshops to prepare you for this effort.

The science test will be administered at grades 4, 8, and 11. All schools are required to participate in the assessments, which are scheduled between May 11<sup>th</sup> and May 28<sup>th</sup>. Test materials will be delivered to your school on April 27<sup>th</sup> and picked-up after testing on May 29<sup>th</sup>. The test will include three sessions—the first two are a written component similar to other NECAP tests, and the third is a performance assessment (the Inquiry Task), which is "hands-on" at grade 4. A series of test administration workshops have been scheduled to help prepare district and school test coordinators for the test. They are scheduled for the following dates and times:

- April 20<sup>th</sup> at the Marriott in Providence (9:00–11:30 a.m. & 1:00–3:30 p.m.)
- April 21<sup>st</sup> at the Radisson in Warwick (9:00–11:30 a.m. & 1:00–3:30 p.m.)
