S - 245 H - 5239	Senator Lenihan Representative Ehrhardt	An Act amending Chapters 425 and 530 of the Public Laws of 2006 and authorizing the Town of North Kingstown to finance renovations, alterations, additions and other improvements and/or related equipment for the Wickford Middle and Davisville Elementary Schools and to issue not more than \$20,100,000 bonds and notes therefor
S - 869 Sub A as amended H - 6149	Senator Cote Representative Brien	An Act authorizing the city of Woonsocket to finance the acquisition of land for school facilities, including the demolition of existing buildings and site preparation, and the construction, furnishing and equipping of two new middle schools and related school facilities and the rehabilitation of appurtenant historic buildings, if any, in the city and to issue not more than \$74,000,000 bonds and/or notes therefor including, but not limited to, any bonds or notes issued pursuant to financing agreements with the Rhode Island Health and Educational Building Corporation.
S - 961 H - 6326	Senator Breene Representative Kennedy	An Act (I) authorizing the Chariho Regional School District to issue not to exceed \$26,000,000 general obligation bonds and/or notes to finance improvements to the Switch Road Campus including, but not limited to the construction, renovation, improvement, demolition, alteration, repair, furnishing and equipping of new construction and additions to the high school, the middle school, the Ryse School, a maintenance facility, a running track, parking, paving and landscaping and (II) amending the Chariho Regional School District Enabling Act to provide that the principal of, redemption premium and interest on bonds and notes issued for these projects will be borne by the member towns in equal amounts, with each member town paying one-third
S - 1035 Sub A as amended H - 6424 Sub A as amended	Senator Blais Representative Mumford	An Act providing for the construction of additions and renovations to the Scituate Middle/High School Complex and authorizing financing thereof, including the issue of not more than \$9,200,000 in bonds therefor. <u>IT SHALL BE A CONDITION PRECEDENT TO RECEIVING THE THIRTY PERCENT (30%) SCHOOL AID REIMBURSEMENT THAT THE SCHOOL RELATED PROJECTS BE APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS PRIOR TO AUGUST 15, 2007.</u>
S - 1095 as amended H - 6514 as amended	Senator Blais Representative Sullivan	An Act authorizing the town of Coventry to finance the acquisition, construction, renovation, demolition, improvement, alteration, repair, additions to, and furnishing and equipping of, new and existing public facilities in the town for use as a government center for town offices, schools, a police station, a senior center library space and other public uses, by the issuance of not more than \$32,250,000 bonds and/or notes therefor. <u>IT SHALL BE A CONDITION PRECEDENT TO RECEIVING THE FORTY-NINE (49%) SCHOOL AID REIMBURSEMENT THAT THE PROJECT IS APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF REGENTS PRIOR TO AUGUST 15, 2007.</u>
H - 5217 as amended	Representative Gallison	An Act authorizing the town of Portsmouth to issue general obligation bonds and/or notes in an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 to finance the acquisition and installation of a wind turbine at Portsmouth High School and/or a wind turbine at Portsmouth Middle School
