SUBJECT: *Final FY 2007 Charter School Aid*

Final FY 2007 charter school entitlements based on the FY 2007 appropriations act are now available on the Rhode Island Department of Education website.

To download the data, go to www.rido.net/funding/forms and click on the entry that reads "Final FY 2007 Charter School Aid." Page 1 shows quarterly state aid to charter schools based on last year's June 30 student count. Page 2 shows projected mid-year adjustments for certain schools which expect to have a 10% or greater change in enrollments for the upcoming school year. Page 3 lists the quarterly aid payments to the sending districts (small dollar amounts are paid in full in the first quarter). Please note that sending district payments are frozen at the FY 2006 level per the FY 2007 budget act and have not been recalculated based on new data. Page 4 shows the per pupil amount owed by each district for pupils sent to a charter plus the total enrollment by district used in the FY 2007 aid calculations.

Please note that actual mid-year adjustments will be calculated based on October 1, 2006 enrollments reported to RIDE, and that any changes in FY 2007 aid based on these calculations will be paid in the January 1, 2007 and April 1, 2007 aid payments.
