High priority projects are those intended repair and/or renovate building systems which are unsound or otherwise in a condition seriously jeopardizing the health and safety of school children. **The SBA Capital Fund will leverage local dollars to complete \$12.7M worth of projects.** These high priority projects will address building, health and fire safety code deficiencies to ensure that building conditions do not interfere with the delivery of a high quality education.
