

The Northeast Regional Credential (NRC), a teacher reciprocity agreement among the states of New England and New York, was sunsetted on June 30, 2006 and is no longer available. From April of 1990 through June of 2006, the NRC program issued more than 4,000 certificates to educators from the six New England states and the state of New York. With the changes and refinements in state standards and the specific requirements of NCLB for Highly Qualified Teachers, the participating states agreed to sunset the NRC program. Current holders of the valid NRC's may continue to use them until their expiration.
