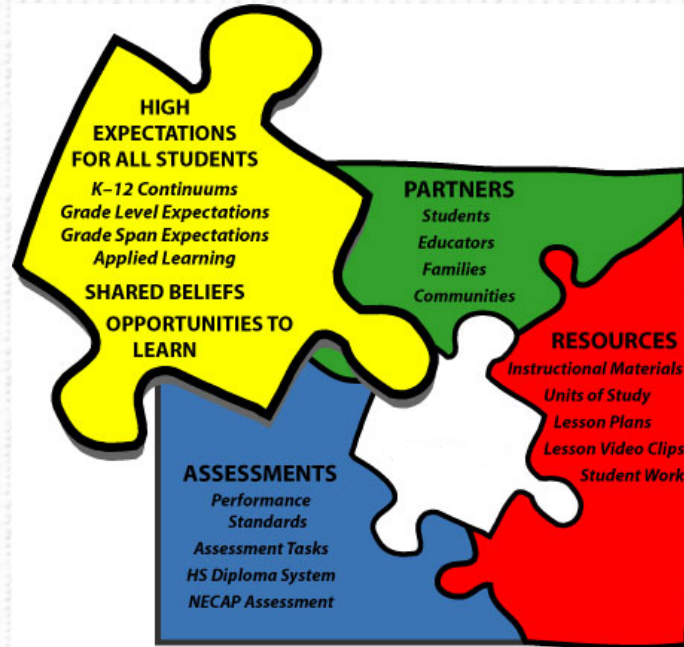

Taking a Look at Student Work

Purpose:

To Establish a Common Understanding of
Levels of Proficiency



Looking at Student Work...

As a team:

- Review all samples of student work
 - Record personal notes about individual pieces of student work
- Calibrate team in accordance with proficiency descriptors & RISWC/NECAP samples



Analyzing Student Work...

As a team:

- Discuss each piece of student work noting:
 - Proficiency Level
 - Evidence to support
 - What does the student work tell you about the students' understanding and the effectiveness of the lesson? (cite examples)
 - What instructional support is needed to improve student learning?
- Refine decisions based upon conversation

Application of Analysis

As a team:

- Select anchor sets of student work
- Utilize anchor sets to:
 - Refine current instruction
 - Evaluation current curriculum
 - Guide student self-assessment
