- Test implementation – determine location and time
 - Computer class / Other
 - Test windows:
 - December 8th – December 19th - Semester 1
 - May 11th – May 22nd – Semester 2
 - Administer practice test
 - Identify technical difficulties prior to testing windows
 - Prepare students for this type of testing
 - Administer TechLiteracy Assessment

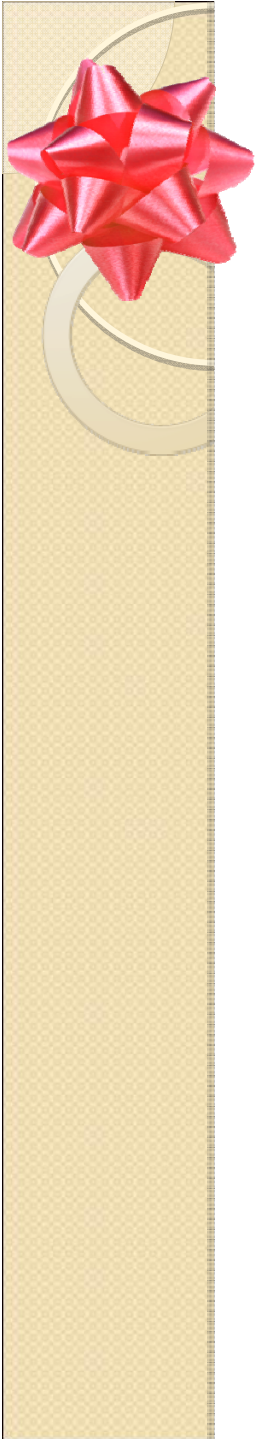


Sample 20 Item Assessment

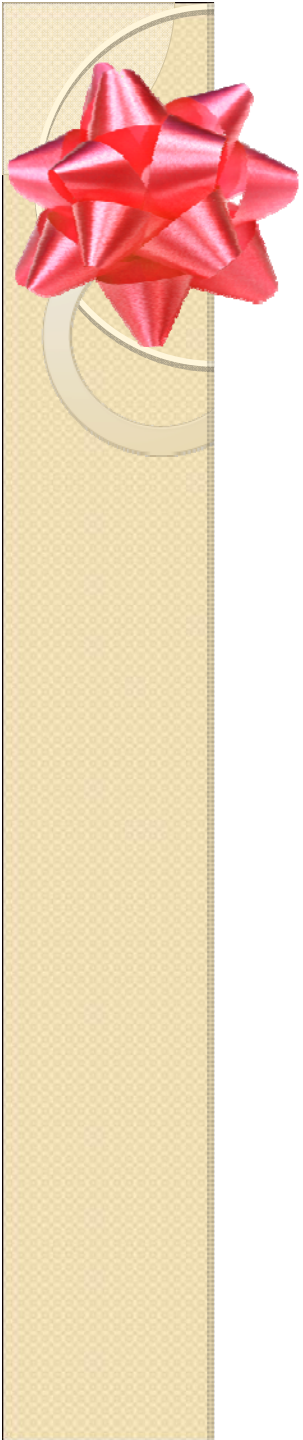
