  - RIDE submits first student registration file to College Board.
- Feb. 22:
  - Last Day to Submit Accommodations into SSD Online
  - Last Day to Submit EL Supports Requests into SSD Online (Extended time for EL students; Bilingual Dictionary/Glossary; Math Only)

- is an accommodation for students with disabilities.
  - Enter accommodation into SSD Online and request materials from [rischoolday@collegeboard.org](mailto:rischoolday@collegeboard.org) or use their online ordering form [Paper Ordering Form](#)
- must be ordered for homeschooled students who decide to participate in PSAT 10 or SAT.
  - Request test materials from [rischoolday@collegeboard.org](mailto:rischoolday@collegeboard.org).
- will be taken by RI students attending schools outside of Rhode Island.
  - College Board will verify student enrollment and materials shipments with out-of-state schools directly.

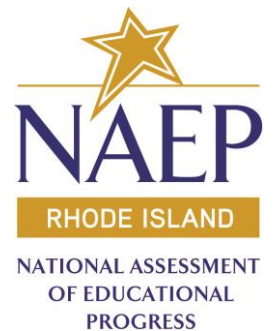

# Updates: RICAS

---

- **PearsonAccessNext (PAN) preparation and upcoming dates**
  - Recommend log in and review/update users/accounts
    - *District test coordinators:* if new test coordinator, reach out to RIDE; if returning and account is disabled, contact the RICAS Service Center Helpdesk for assistance
    - *School test coordinators and district staff:* contact your district test coordinator to create/re-enable your account
  - Updates made for Spring 2022 administration – please register for the RICAS Test Coordinator Training session on February 2 (any test coordinators) or February 10 (new test coordinators only) at [www.ride.ri.gov/assessment-training](http://www.ride.ri.gov/assessment-training)
  - Initial SR/PNP window (paper tests for accommodations): **February 7 to February 18** (will review during training)
- **RICAS Service Center site password reset for Spring 2022**
  - *Principals/School Test Coordinators:* starting January 20 will receive a letter containing your school password
  - *District Test Coordinators:* superintendents will receive a letter with the passwords for all schools in their district starting January 20

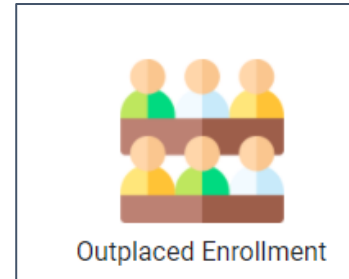
# Outplacement Student Enrollment Data

---

- Report 1: Outplaced Enrollment
  - For outplacement schools to verify the data RIDE receives from LEAs.
- Report 2: Outplaced Student Report
  - For LEAs that tuition students to outplacement schools.
- WHY?
  - Student information for students in outplacement schools is notoriously out of date and inaccurate.
  - It is difficult for LEAs and outplacement schools to verify student information without RIDE being the intermediary. These new reports allow the LEA and the schools to see where the problems are and to fix them quickly.

# Outplaced Enrollment Application

- For Outplacement Schools only. Administrators must have RIDE Portal account. All administrators will be verified before RIDE assigns this application.
- Steps:
  1. Log in to RIDE portal: <https://portal.ride.ri.gov/Account/Login>
  2. Click on All Applications on the left-hand side of the screen.
  3. Click on the *Outplaced Enrollment* application:



4. Select the School Year: 2021-22

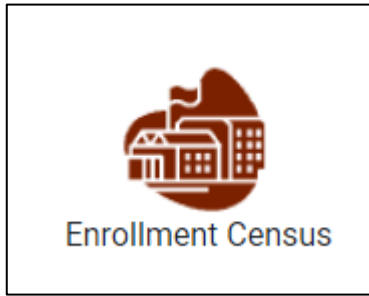
