### CHALLENGES YOU HAD:

- Difficulties of the journey (describe the steamship, etc.)

- Three things you brought with you (should make sense for the time period!) Each item must come from a different category:
  - An item that would remind you of home
  - An item that would entertain you on the journey

### Map of Migration:

- The map you created including: compass rose, longitude and latitude of start/end locations, key or legend, and scale
